The Youth Leadership workshop series provides education and training about the criminal justice system. Workshops use structured learning activities to enhance the competency of youth who have a developmental disability.

We require all youth who are involved with court-ordered services to attend Youth Leadership training. Each class is led by a qualified trainer, teacher, or therapist.

Youth Leadership classes focus on:

- Criminal justice
- Social skills
- Anger management training
- Academic tutoring

Classes Meet Regularly
